WHEREAS the Executive wishes to execute a loan agreement with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce in an amount not to exceed \$220,000.00, the proceeds of which shall strictly be used by the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce to provide grants to CDBG-eligible Businesses under the Program, that will be reimbursed with CDBG Funds, to paid from the

County General Fund as set forth in Exhibit D, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to maximize the assistance available through the Program and provide funding for grant awards in excess of \$1,000,000.00, the Executive and Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce further desire to encourage fund contributions for the purpose of providing Program grants from governmental entities, businesses, non-profits, and individuals who wish to contribute to the Program and have outlined the manner in which these organizations can contribute funds and direct how those funds may be used, as defined in the Program Guidelines, which are attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to appropriate \$750,000.00 from the General Fund to fund a \$530,000.00 grant agreement and a \$220,000.00 loan agreement, both with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to appropriate CDBG funds totaling \$220,000.00 to fund a Community Development Block Grant contract with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to create the Summit County COVID-19 Small Business Emergency Relief Grant Program and adopt the Program Guidelines, which are attached hereto as Exhibit A, as may be amended from time to time, execute a grant agreement with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce in an amount not to exceed \$530,000.00 as set forth in Exhibit B, execute a Community Development Block Grant contract with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce in an amount not to exceed \$220,000.00 as set forth in Exhibit C, execute a loan agreement with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce in an amount not to exceed \$220,000.00 as set forth in Exhibit D, and to appropriate funds totaling \$970,000.00;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 This Council hereby authorizes the creation of the Summit County COVID-19 Small Business Emergency Relief Grant Program ("the Program") and adopts the Program Guidelines, which are attached hereto as Exhibit A, as may be amended by the Executive from time to time, in a manner not materially adverse to the County and hereby approves the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce to manage the Program. All proposed amendments to the Program shall require 48 hours' notice to this Council, prior to their enactment, by the Executive.

SECTION 2

This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute a grant agreement with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce in an amount not to exceed \$530,000.00 to paid from the County General Fund as set forth in Exhibit B, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 3

This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute a Community Development Block Grant contract with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce in an amount not to exceed \$220,000.00 as set forth in Exhibit C, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 4

This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute a loan agreement with the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce in an amount not to exceed \$220,000.00, the proceeds of which shall strictly be used by the Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce to provide grants to CDBG-eligible Businesses under the Program, that will be reimbursed with CDBG Funds, to be paid from the County General Fund, as set forth in Exhibit D, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 5

This Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute all other agreements and documents necessary to create and administer the Program upon terms substantially similar to and not materially adverse to the County, as may be necessary.
