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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Ganley Ford, Inc. for the purchase of six 2020 Ford Explorer police interceptor models, at**
9 **less than CUE pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$196,080.00, for the Sheriff, and**
10 **declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 11, 2020, awarded a
13 purchase contract with Ganley Ford, Inc. for the purchase of six 2020 Ford Explorer police
14 interceptor models, at less than CUE pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$196,080.00, subject to
15 confirmation by County Council; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Ganley Ford, Inc. is necessary and in the best
19 interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract to Ganley Ford, Inc. for the
27 purchase of six 2020 Ford Explorer police interceptor models, at less than CUE pricing, in an
28 amount not to exceed \$196,080.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby
29 authorized to execute such purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

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31 SECTION 2

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33 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
34 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
35 provide for necessary law enforcement vehicles for the Sheriff.

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37 SECTION 3

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39 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
40 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
41 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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43 SECTION 4

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45 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
46 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
47 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
48 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
49 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


