A Resolution, pursuant to Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, authorizing purchases by the County Executive from Pelton Environmental Products, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for operations within the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, in calendar year 2020, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$85,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit requires that purchases by an officeholder exceeding \$50,000.00 in the aggregate in any calendar year, where no additional competitive quotes or bids have been taken, shall be made only upon authorization of County Council; and

WHEREAS, ultraviolet disinfection is used to destroy bacteria in wastewater treatment at all six County wastewater treatment plants and the County uses Trojan brand ultraviolet systems as a standard for said facilities and Pelton Environmental Products, Inc., located at 8638 Cotter Street, Lewis Center, OH is the exclusive manufacturers' representative of parts and services for Trojan Technologies in the state of Ohio.; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive anticipates making purchases of Trojan ultraviolet disinfection systems from Pelton Environmental Products, Inc., during calendar year 2020, and requests that she be authorized to make said purchases as a Best Practical Source, for operations within the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services in calendar year 2020, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$85,000.00; and

WHEREAS, replacement of equipment at Plant 32 in New Franklin is included in the Fiscal Year 2020 capital improvements budget and replacement equipment for the other County facilities is included in the Fiscal Year 2020 operating budget; and

WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize purchases by the County Executive from Pelton Environmental Products, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for operations within the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services in calendar year 2020, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$85,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 Pursuant to Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, this Council hereby authorizes purchases by the County Executive from Pelton Environmental Products, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for operations within the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services in calendar year 2020, in a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$85,000.00.

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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize necessary purchases for operations within the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services in calendar year 2020.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
