A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with the Community Health Center, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, in an amount not to exceed \$98,000.00, in calendar year 2020, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation Department, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation Department ("the Court") has used Community Health Center ("CHC") to drug test adult probationers for a number of years, as CHC provides the most extensive and observed testing in Summit County; and

WHEREAS, the Court spent \$98,000.00 on drug testing in 2019 and anticipates the costs to be comparable in 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its January 29, 2020, meeting, awarded a purchase contract with the Community Health Center, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, in an amount not to exceed \$98,000.00, in calendar year 2020; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract with CHC is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with the Community Health Center, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services, in an amount not to exceed \$98,000.00, in calendar year 2020, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide necessary drug screen testing services for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation Department in calendar year 2020.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
