A Resolution authorizing the County Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety and Emergency Management Agency to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training and planning sessions to be held in 2020, for the County Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety and Emergency Management Agency conducts various training and planning sessions, including domestic preparedness steering committee workshops and law enforcement, fire, dispatch and emergency medical services personnel training, for the County of Summit and Ohio Homeland Security Region 5 law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, such training sessions are attended by County employees, public safety personnel, outside organizations and elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety and Emergency Management Agency wish to make hospitality expenses, in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00, for 2020 related to the aforementioned training sessions, all of which are paid for through various grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Ohio issued Opinion No. 82-006, which authorizes the expenditure of funds by a local political subdivision for its employees as long as those expenditures are necessary to further a public purpose and if the political subdivision's determination to make such expenditures is not manifestly arbitrary or unreasonable; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.24 (b) and (c) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit require the approval of County Council for hospitality expenditures exceeding \$2,000.00 per year and for hospitality expenditures for purposes other than employee training, meetings and organization strategic planning meetings; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety and Emergency Management Agency to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training sessions to be held in 2020 and that such expenditures are for a valid public purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

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## SECTION 1

The County Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety and Emergency Management Agency is hereby authorized to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing planning and training sessions to be held in 2020. This Council hereby finds and determines that such expenditures are for a valid public purpose.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately authorizing the Department of Law and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety and Emergency Management Agency to make expenditures for hospitality items incurred in providing training sessions to be held in 2020.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
