7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept the award of a FFY 2015 Victims of Crime Act grant from the Ohio Attorney**  
9 **General's Office, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in the amount of \$619.66, with no**  
10 **local cash match requirement, and appropriating said grant funds, for the County of**  
11 **Summit Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division has  
14 received an award from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year  
15 ("FFY") 2015 Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") grant for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in  
16 the amount of \$619.66, with no local cash match requirement; and

18 WHEREAS, the grant is to allow a juvenile court employee to attend the 2015 Two Days  
19 in May Victims Assistance conference in Columbus, Ohio; and

21 WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents  
22 necessary to accept the aforementioned FFY 2015 VOCA grant and to appropriate grant funds  
23 for expenditures through 12/31/15; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
27 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY  
28 2015 VOCA grant and to appropriate these grant funds for expenditures through 12/31/15;
