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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental**
8 **agreement with the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas Domestic Relations**
9 **Division, for reimbursement of magistrate hearings, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15,**
10 **in an amount not to exceed \$800,487.42, for the Prosecutor - Child Support Enforcement**
11 **Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 11, 2015, awarded an
14 intergovernmental agreement with the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas Domestic
15 Relations Division, for reimbursement of magistrate hearings addressing IV-D provider contract
16 matters, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental agreement with the County
27 of Summit Court of Common Pleas Domestic Relations Division, for reimbursement of
28 magistrate hearings addressing IV-D provider contract matters, for the period 1/1/15 through
29 12/31/15, in an amount not to exceed \$800,487.42, is hereby confirmed and the County
30 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such agreement.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
36 provide for reimbursement of magistrate hearings in 2015.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
