WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services ("ODPS-OCJS") has awarded the Common Pleas Court-General Division an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, in the amount of \$33,332.02 with a 50% local cash match requirement of \$33,332.02; and

WHEREAS, this Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance grant will assist agencies with implementation of programs designed to improve the domestic lifestyle of residents of Summit County; and
