A Resolution, pursuant to Section 177.19 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, authorizing the disposal of certain surplus firearms by the Sheriff through tradein, in the amount of \$22,282.00, against the purchase of new supplies from Pro Armament Company, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff is in the possession of certain surplus firearms, as set forth in Exhibit A attached to this Resolution, that are no longer needed for use by the Sheriff's office; and

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff and County Executive have determined that disposal of said surplus firearms is necessary, and have received an offer from Pro Armanent Company to trade in said firearms for the amount of \$22,282.00 against the purchase of new supplies; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 177.19 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, personal property cumulatively exceeding \$15,000.00 may be sold without a public auction or sealed bids if this Council finds good cause as to why a public auction or sealed bid is not warranted: and

WHEREAS, this Council hereby finds that good cause exists not to sell said surplus firearms at a public auction or sealed bid and to instead deal directly with a dealer serving the law enforcement community; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the disposal of said surplus firearms by the Sheriff through trade in, in the amount of \$22,282.00, against the purchase of new supplies from Pro Armament Company;
