A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a quit-claim deed to transfer 6 parcels of County-owned real property located in the Township of Springfield, Council District 8, to the Township of Springfield, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County was granted a quit claim deed for 6 parcels of real property in 1969 from the Ohio Edison Company, in a deed recorded at Volume 4876, pages 418-421 in the Summit County Records ("the Parcels"), which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Parcels are narrow strips of land located along the right-of-way along Canton Road, and were historically used as a trolley car line running from Akron to Canton, which has been abandoned for many decades; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Springfield plans to use the Parcels as part of a hike and bike trail; and

WHEREAS, the County has no use for, and no reason to retain control of, the Parcels, which could better utilized and developed by the Township of Springfield as a hike and bike trail; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.16(e) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit authorizes the transfer of County-owned real property to a subdivision of the State of Ohio upon approval of this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to execute a quit-claim deed to transfer the Parcels to the Township of Springfield.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
