A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a Juvenile Accountability Block Grant from the Ohio Department of Youth Services in the amount of \$21,719.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$2,413.00, for the period 6/1/10 through 5/31/11, and appropriating the total of \$24,132.00 for police officer training expenditures through 12/31/10, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Youth Services ("ODYS") has awarded to the County of Summit Juvenile Court a Juvenile Accountability Block Grant ("JABG") for police officer training expenditures in the amount of \$21,719.00, with a local cash match requirement to be made from the Reclaim fund in the amount of \$2,413.00, for the period 6/1/10 through 5/31/11 as a one time discretionary funding award; and

WHEREAS, this grant will provide "Effective Interaction with Youth" training developed by the Connecticut Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee, which has proven to be effective in reducing juvenile arrests by improving the interactions between police and youth; and

WHEREAS, the youth benefit by having a better understanding of how law enforcement and the Juvenile Justice system works, and they gain an understanding of how their actions influence how police officers react to them; and

WHEREAS, the law enforcement officers gain an understanding of youth culture so they are less likely to misinterpret actions; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the ODYS, and to appropriate these grant funds;
