A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept three awards from the National Court Appointed Special Advocates Association, including a federal Department of Justice award with no local cash match requirement, for a capacity building grant in the amount of \$7,000.00, and a second DOJ award with no local cash match requirement for a diversity implementation grant in the amount of \$5,500.00, and a CASA grant from Jewelers for Children for an association sustainability grant in the amount of \$39,000.00, matched with local funds of \$20,000.00, for a total of \$59,000.00, for the period 7/1/10 through 6/30/11, and appropriating these funds for CASA expenditures through 12/31/10, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the National Court Appointed Special Advocates Association ("National CASA) is a nonprofit organization which offers consultation and resources to help provide programs for abused and neglected children; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court maintains a CASA program to provide every child who enters the court system as a result of allegations of abuse, neglect or dependency with a trained volunteer to advocate in court for what is in the child's best interest; and

WHEREAS, National CASA has awarded the County of Summit Juvenile Court a capacity building grant funded by the Department of Justice ("DOJ")–Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, in the amount of \$7,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 7/1/10 through 6/30/11, to be used to expand the number of volunteers in the local CASA program; and

WHEREAS, National CASA has also awarded the Juvenile Court a diversity implementation grant funded by the DOJ-Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, in the amount of \$5,500.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 7/1/10 through 6/30/11, to be used to expand the number of minority volunteers in the local CASA program to more closely mirror the population served; and

WHEREAS, National CASA has also awarded the Juvenile Court a sustainability grant of private funds from the Jewelers for Children, in the amount of \$39,000.00, which will be supplemented with \$20,000.00 in local cash match funds from the Court's general fund, appropriated in Resolution 2009-469, for the period 7/1/10 through 6/30/11, to be used to support a Volunteer Coordinator position; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the awards of the aforementioned grants from the National CASA and to appropriate these grant funds;
