7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept an award from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services of a Workforce**
9 **Investment Act grant for the One-Stop Enhancement Program for Area 20, in an amount**
10 **which includes both State Fiscal Year 2010 and State Fiscal Year 2011 funds totaling**
11 **\$194,500.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating the Fiscal Year 2010**
12 **award of \$64,185.00, for the period 4/21/10 through 12/31/10, and the balance of**
13 **\$130,315.00, for the period 7/1/10 through 12/31/10, for the Executive's Department of Job**
14 **and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services has granted a Workforce
17 Investment Act grant, in the amount of \$194,500.00, for a One-Stop Enhancement Program for
18 Area 20, being Summit and Medina Counties, with one-third of the award being \$64,185.00,
19 immediately available for State Fiscal Year 2010, with an extension through 12/31/10, and the
20 balance being State Fiscal Year 2011 funds in the amount of \$130,315.00, available 7/1/10
21 through 12/31/10; and

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23 WHEREAS, this plan is to help the WIA Area 20 to assist One-Stop customers with
24 Resource Room improvements, technological upgrades/purchases, and continuous improvement
25 efforts; and

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27 WHEREAS, these funds are in accordance with Section 4141.11 of the Ohio Revised
28 Code and are part of an \$8,000,000.00 project of state funds to implement and enhance physical
29 and technological access to services for job-seeking individuals and employers and to provide
30 for continuous improvement efforts in service delivery; and

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32 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services is the principle
33 agency for WIA Area 20, and responsible of the distribution of \$41,092.00 to Summit County
34 and \$23,093.00 to Medina County; and

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36 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
37 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
38 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from ODJFS and to
39 appropriate these grant funds;

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41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit,
42 State of Ohio, that:

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44 SECTION 1

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46 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
47 the Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") One-Stop System Enhancement award from the Ohio
48 Department of Job and Family Services, for the period through 12/31/10, in the amount of
49 \$194,500.00, with no local cash match requirement.

39 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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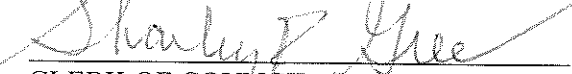

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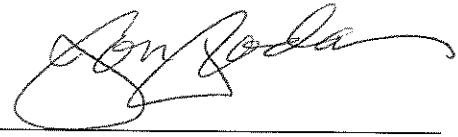
