A Resolution supporting the Cleveland Museum of Natural History's Clean Ohio Grant Application for the Long Lake Bog and Singer Lake Bog Preservation Project in Coventry Township and the City of Green, in Council District 8, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Cleveland Museum of Natural History intends to submit an application for a Clean Ohio Grant for the purchase of 68 acres of land in Summit County, including 58 acres of land known as the Long Lake Bog in Coventry Township and 10 acres of land adjacent to Singer Lake in the City of Green, which will become a portion of the 344-acre Singer Lake Bog Preserve; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of these lands will ensure conservation of the land, protect high quality wetlands on the land, protect the rare and natural habitat for 18 state-listed rare species, and will assist with the implementation of the Summit County Trail and Greenway Plan; and

WHEREAS, preservation of the wetlands on the project sites will help maintain ground water supply and quality within the Tuscarawas River Watershed; and

WHEREAS, this Council concurs with the goals of the Cleveland Museum of Natural History to preserve, conserve and protect the natural features of Summit County and to provide the opportunity for enjoyment and appreciation of those natural resources; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to support the Cleveland Museum of Natural History's Clean Ohio Grant Application for the Long Lake Bog and Singer Lake Bog Preservation Project in Coventry Township and the City of Green;
