18	the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
19	continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire
20	said employees; and

22	WHEREAS, the Prosecutor says it is necessary for the continued and effective operation
23	of her office to be permitted to hire a full-time Attorney I position, which is an entry-level
24 25	position within the Prosecutor's Office, to fill a vacancy due to a resignation effective 9/10/10, up to the midpoint of the pay range for the position; and
