7 **A Resolution confirming the Board of Control's award of a super blanket encumbrance to**  
8 **pay agencies in the communities of Stow, Silver Lake, Peninsula, Barberton, Boston**  
9 **Heights, Akron Richfield, Springfield and New Franklin assigned by the Ohio Department**  
10 **of Public Safety ("ODPS") to the Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI")**  
11 **Task Force, in an amount not to exceed \$105,770.00, to be paid out of \$206,392.05 in**  
12 **federal funds awarded by ODPS to the County Sheriff, with no local cash match**  
13 **requirement, for the period 10/1/10 to 9/30/11, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, the ODPS, through the Governor's Highway Safety Office, offers funding  
16 for a countywide OVI Task Force program in the County of Summit; and

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18 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Sheriff's Office has been awarded \$206,392.05, with  
19 no local cash match requirement, to create a countywide OVI Task Force program to conduct  
20 high visibility enforcement, public awareness, and education for alcohol-related crashes and  
21 traffic-related fatalities in Summit County; and

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23 WHEREAS, there is legislation pending before this Council to authorize the County  
24 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the OVI grant and to appropriate grant  
25 funds; and

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27 WHEREAS, at its October 13, 2010 meeting, the Board of Control awarded a super  
28 blanket encumbrance to pay agencies in the communities of Stow, Silver Lake, Peninsula,  
29 Barberton, Boston Heights, Akron Richfield, Springfield and New Franklin assigned by the Ohio  
30 Department of Public Safety ("ODPS") to the Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated  
31 ("OVI") Task Force, in an amount not to exceed \$105,770.00, to be paid out of OVI Task Force  
32 grant funds; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that  
35 confirming the award by the Board of Control of the super blanket encumbrance for the OVI  
36 Task Force is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

43 The Board of Control's award of a super blanket encumbrance to pay agencies in the  
44 communities of Stow, Silver Lake, Peninsula, Barberton, Boston Heights, Akron Richfield,  
45 Springfield and New Franklin assigned by the Ohio Department of Public Safety ("ODPS") to  
46 the Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force, in an amount not to  
47 exceed \$105,770.00, to be paid out of \$206,392.05 in federal funds awarded by ODPS to the  
48 County Sheriff, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/10 to 9/30/11, is  
49 hereby confirmed and the payment of the aforementioned agencies is hereby authorized.

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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately provide for the payment of agencies in communities assigned to the OVI Task Force program by the ODPS.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
