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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept a Fiscal Year (“FY”) 2010 Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) award of federal funds**  
9 **from the City of Akron, in the amount of \$12,000.00, with no local cash match requirement,**  
10 **available 10/1/09 through 9/30/13, and appropriating grant funds for expenditures through**  
11 **12/31/10, for the Executive’s Department of Law, Division of Public Safety – Justice Affairs**  
12 **Office, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the City of Akron had applied for, and received, a FY 2010 JAG Grant with  
15 a project period of 10/1/09 to 9/30/2013, a portion of which is to be used specifically for the  
16 County of Summit’s criminal justice programs; and

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18 WHEREAS, appropriations are required for this pass-through funding which will support  
19 the development and enhancement of programs within the criminal justice system, and will be  
20 identified in a memorandum of understanding from the City of Akron; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
23 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to  
24 execute any documents necessary to accept the FY 2010 JAG award of federal funds from the  
25 City of Akron, in the amount of \$12,000.00, with no local cash match required, available through  
26 9/30/13, and to appropriate grant funds for expenditures through 12/31/10;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
29 of Ohio, that:

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33 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
34 a Fiscal Year (“FY”) 2010 Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) award of federal funds from the  
35 City of Akron, in the amount of \$12,000.00, available through 9/30/13 with no local cash match  
36 requirement.


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SECTION 6
