SECTION 1 (cont'd.)

Oriana shall pay all costs related to the building foundation repairs under County supervision of the repairs and the award of contracts pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 177 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and pursuant to Section 4(b) of the Operating Agreement, the cost of the repairs shall be set-off against any potential purchase by Oriana of the Facility as set forth in Section 5 of the Operating Agreement.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow emergency building foundation repairs to be made to the Residential Correction Center.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
