A Resolution authorizing appropriation proceedings of property owned by Joseph Weatherby, III, needed for the replacement of the Northampton Road bridge over Mud Run, located in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Council District 3, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, permanent, temporary, and slope easements of right of way are needed for the replacement of the Northampton Road Bridge over Mud Run, Ohio Department of Transportation project identification number PID 84446 SUM-CH27, Section 04.35 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit, despite negotiations, has been unable to acquire all of the rights of way necessary for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and Joseph Weatherby, III, are unable to agree upon the purchase price of the right of way on property owned by Joseph Weatherby, III; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said right of way by court proceedings under the provisions of Section 5555.09 and Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

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The County of Summit hereby declares its intention to appropriate a Warranty Deed with Reservation of Access, a temporary easement for highway purposes, and a slope easement in the real property described by Exhibit A, attached hereto; said purposes to include the replacement of the Northampton Road Bridge and the widening of said bridge and roadway approaches thereto, said property being owned by Joseph Weatherby, III ("Owner"), located in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Council District 3, and designated as Parcel 4WD, Parcel 4SL, and Parcel 4T.

SECTION 2

The County Prosecuting Attorney is hereby directed to prepare and file on behalf of the County of Summit, Ohio, proceedings for appropriation, under the provisions of Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code, of said easement and temporary right of way.

SECTION 3

The County Engineer, through the County Fiscal Officer, is hereby authorized to draw by voucher upon the County of Summit and pay into the Court of Common Pleas at the time of the filing of a complaint for the appropriation of said parcels, under the provisions of Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code, a sum not to exceed \$ 3,102.76.

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SECTION 4

This Resolution shall be published in accordance with Council Rule 8.08; published on the internet and/or posted at 175 South Main Street, Akron, Ohio.

SECTION 5

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow commencement of an improvement to the County's highway system.

SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 7

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
