7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a Local Public Agency**
8 **agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for bridge**
9 **load ratings of forty-two bridges throughout the County of Summit, in all Council Districts,**
10 **at a cost not to exceed \$85,320.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Engineer finds a public need for performing bridge load ratings on the
13 East North Street over Little Cuyahoga River, Home Avenue over Little Cuyahoga River,
14 Harrington Road over Tuscarawas Diversion Dam, Riverview Road over Sand Run Creek, South
15 Main Street over Brewster Creek and Skelton Road over Little Cuyahoga River in the City of
16 Akron, Hudson Run Road over Wolf Creek and Wooster Road over Hudson Run in the City of
17 Barberton, Yellow Creek Road over Yellow Creek, Granger Road over Yellow Creek, Granger
18 Road over North Fork, Ira Road over North Fork, Bath Road over Bath Ditch and Hametown
19 Road over Branch Yellow Creek in Bath Township, Riverview Road over Branch Cuyahoga
20 River and Hine Hill Road over Stanford Ditch in Boston Township, Knox Boulevard over
21 Pigeon Creek in Copley Township, Arlington Road over Tuscarawas River and Turkeyfoot
22 Drive over Turkeyfoot Channel in Coventry Township, Ridgewood Road over Shocalog Ditch in
23 the City of Fairlawn, Van Buren Road over Tuscarawas River, Center Road over Tuscarawas
24 River and Grill Road over Pancake Creek in the City of New Franklin, Christman Road over
25 Lake Y-Noah Outlet and Raber Road over Branch Tuscarawas River in the City of Green,
26 Hudson-Aurora Road over Tinkers Creek, Terex Road over Norfolk Southern Railway, Hudson-
27 Aurora Road over Wager Ditch, Seasons Road over Power Brook and Seasons Road over Mud
28 Brook in the City of Hudson, Bedford Road over Indian Creek in the City of Macedonia, Barber
29 Road over Wolf Creek in the City of Norton, Harter Road over East Branch Rocky River in
30 Richfield Township, Houghton Road over Branch Sagamore Creek in Sagamore Hills Township,
31 Pressler Road over South Fork Tuscarawas River and Pressler Road over Branch Tuscarawas
32 River in Springfield Township, Miktarian Parkway over Tinkers Creek, Miktarian Parkway over
33 Wheeling & Lake Erie Railroad and Ravenna Road over Branch Tinkers Creek in City of
34 Twinsburg, and Old Mill Road over Tinkers Creek, Chamberlin Road East over Norfolk
35 Southern Railway and Chamberlin Road West over Norfolk Southern Railway in Twinsburg
36 Township in the interest of public safety; and

38 WHEREAS, the Bridge Load Rating Project (“Project”) has been selected for additional
39 federal funding having received Federal High Administration (“FHWA”) approval; and

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41 WHEREAS, the Project’s estimated cost is \$85,320.00; and

42
43 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) shall provide the Local
44 Public Agency (LPA) 80% of the eligible costs, up to a maximum of \$68,256.000; and

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46 WHEREAS, the Engineer plans to provide the remainder of the Project’s Cost, in an
47 amount not to exceed \$17,064.00; and

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49 WHEREAS, ODOT and the Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency (“LPA”)
50 agreement, to confirm the Project’s Cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead
51 agency for administration of consultant selection of the Project; and

4 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03 (c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as
5 Article II, Section 2.03 (5) of the Charter of the County of Summit allows execution of such
6 agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

7
8 WHEREAS, no funds will be expended for the Project until and unless authorized by
9 separate resolution; and

10
11 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
12 authorizing the County Executive to enter into the aforementioned LPA agreement with ODOT
13 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
16 of Ohio, that:

17
18 SECTION 1

19
20 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a Local Public Agency
21 agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for bridge load
22 ratings of forty-two bridges throughout the County of Summit, in all Council Districts.

23
24 SECTION 2

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26 The terms of said agreement shall include the following:

- 27
28 a. That the parties estimate the Project's Cost to be \$85,320.00, with said cost including
29 inspection and load rating analysis;
- 30
31 b. That the net estimated cost to Summit County shall be an amount not to exceed
32 \$17,064.00; and
- 33
34 c. That Summit County shall provide all other financial resources necessary to fully
35 complete the Project.

37 SECTION 3

38
39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
40 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
41 completes a prerequisite for a bridge improvement needed for safe and convenient travel within
42 the County.

44 SECTION 4

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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
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4 SECTION 5
