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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to prepare and submit an application with**  
8 **the Ohio Public Works Commission (“OPWC”) for a grant to be used to finance the cost of**  
9 **the Pump Station #56 Abandonment Project Q-162 (“Project”), located in the City of**  
10 **Macedonia, Council District 1, for the Executive’s Department of Environmental Services,**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvements Program provides financial assistance to  
14 political subdivisions for capital improvement projects to public infrastructure; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County desires to apply for a grant from the OPWC to finance the cost  
17 of the Project, which would entail eliminating Pump Station No. 56 located in the City of  
18 Macedonia, Council District 1, and the installation of approximately 815 feet of 12-inch sanitary  
19 sewer, with the total Project cost of approximately \$120,000; and

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21 WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that  
22 it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to apply for said funds, and to  
23 authorize the execution of any necessary agreements and associated documents;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
26 of Ohio, that:

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is authorized to prepare and submit an application and associated  
31 documents to the Ohio Public Works Commission (“OPWC”) to obtain a grant to finance the  
32 Pump Station #56 Abandonment Project Q-162 (“Project”), located in the City of Macedonia,  
33 Council District 1.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 The terms of said application and associated documents shall maximize the requested  
38 amount of State Issue 1 funds, with the remainder of the cost of the improvements to be borne by  
39 the County of Summit through the Executive’s Department of Environmental Services Capital  
40 Improvements Program funding, with a total cost to the County estimated to be \$60,000.00.

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42 SECTION 3

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44 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
45 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will  
46 immediately allow the County to apply for grant funds for a necessary improvement.

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4 SECTION 4

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6 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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10 SECTION 5

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12 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
13 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
14 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
15 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
