7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an agreement with Summit County**
8 **Children Services (“SCCS”) whereby the Prosecutor will serve as legal counsel for SCCS in**
9 **the prosecution of dependency and neglect cases, in consideration of SCCS seeking federal**
10 **financial participation under Title IV-E of the Social Security Act, 42 USCA 670-679c., of**
11 **the Prosecutor’s allowable costs and remitting said federal funds to the Prosecutor, for the**
12 **Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

13
14 WHEREAS, SCCS is responsible for preventing child dependency and neglect within
15 Summit County; and

16
17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 309 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Prosecutor serves as
18 legal counsel for SCCS in the prosecution of dependency and neglect cases; and

19
20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Title IV-E of the Social Security Act., 42 USCA 670-679c.,
21 certain costs associated with the Prosecutor’s representation of SCCS in dependency and neglect
22 cases are allowable for federal financial participation; and

23
24 WHEREAS, the Executive, Prosecutor and SCCS desire to enter into an agreement
25 whereby the Prosecutor will serve as legal counsel for SCCS in the prosecution of dependency
26 and neglect cases in consideration of SCCS seeking federal financial participation under Title
27 IV-E of the Prosecutor’s allowable costs and remitting said federal funds to the Prosecutor; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest
30 of the County to authorize the Executive to enter into an agreement with SCCS whereby the
31 Prosecutor will serve as legal counsel for SCCS in the prosecution of dependency and neglect
32 cases in consideration of SCCS seeking federal financial participation under Title IV-E of the
33 Prosecutor’s allowable costs and remitting said federal funds to the Prosecutor.

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
36 State of Ohio, that:

40 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Summit
41 County Children Services (“SCCS”) whereby the Prosecutor will serve as legal counsel for
42 SCCS in the prosecution of dependency and neglect cases in consideration of SCCS seeking
43 federal financial participation under Title IV-E of the Social Security Act., 42 USCA 670-679c.,
44 of the Prosecutor’s allowable costs and remitting said federal funds to the Prosecutor.

48 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety
49 and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary
50 to immediately authorize the execution of the aforesaid agreement so that the Prosecutor may
51 immediately begin to receive the Title IV-E funds from federal financial participation.
