7 **An amended Resolution adjusting existing appropriations by \$18,000.00 within the**  
8 **Computerization Fund and \$25,000.00 within the Title Administration Fund for the period**  
9 **ending 12/31/11, for the County of Summit Clerk of Courts, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2010-497, the County of Summit's 2011 Permanent Budget,  
12 appropriated expenditures of \$848,800.00 in the Computerization Fund, and \$2,202,700.00 in  
13 the Title Administration Funds for the Clerk of Courts for the period ending 12/31/11; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, it is necessary to transfer appropriations of \$18,000.00 from Contract  
16 Services into Salaries, within the Computerization Fund, in order to fund overtime costs, which  
17 were incurred as a result of the implementation of the Clerk's Case Management System; and

19 WHEREAS, it is necessary to transfer appropriations of \$25,000.00 from Equipment  
20 into Salaries, within the Title Administration Fund, in order to support overtime costs, which  
21 were incurred as a result of providing service to the public on Saturdays at the Title Bureau  
22 locations ~~the implementation of the Clerk's Case Management System~~; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information  
25 that the adjustment appropriations in the aforementioned funds is necessary and in the best  
26 interest of the County of Summit;
