A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from the Ohio Department of Youth Services, as part of a funding collaborative, of a Fiscal Year 2013 Behavioral Health and Juvenile Justice grant, in the amount of \$315,901.00, with no local cash match requirement, with a performance period of 7/1/12 through 6/30/13, and appropriating \$315,901.00 through 12/31/12, for the County of Summit Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a fourth Behavioral Health and Juvenile Justice ("BHJJ") grant for Fiscal Year 2013, from the Ohio Department of Youth Services, for the funding of a local collaborative in providing services to youths with behavioral needs, in the amount of \$315,901.00, with no local cash match requirement, with a performance period of 7/1/12 through 6/30/13; and

WHEREAS, this funding is to continue the support of integrated co-occurring treatment and trauma focused cognitive behavioral therapy, in addressing those issues for both the serious juvenile offender youth and their families, with the ultimate goal to positively affect behavior, improve coping skills, provide safe and healthy alternatives, and prepare these youth and families to function positively and productively in the home and community; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned Fiscal Year 2013 BHJJ grant from the Ohio Department of Youth Services, and to appropriate these grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from the Ohio Department of Youth Services, as part of a funding collaborative, of a Behavioral Health and Juvenile Justice ("BHJJ") grant, in the amount of \$315,901.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 7/1/12 through 6/30/13.
