7 **A Resolution appropriating carryover funds, within various programs including**
8 **Community Development Block Grants, Housing Advisory Board, Energy Efficiency**
9 **Community Block Grants, HOME, and Lead Grants, for a total amount of \$880,323.25, for**
10 **the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, for the Executive's Department of Community and**
11 **Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, various programs funds for the Executive's Department of Community and
14 Economic Development were appropriated for 2011 in Resolution No. 2010-497 and carryover
15 Resolution No. 2011-032; and

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17 WHEREAS, unexpended funds remain in these various programs at calendar year end
18 2011 that must be appropriated through 12/31/12; and

20 WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grants ("CDBG"), and Home and Lead
21 Reduction funds will assist low and moderate income individuals and areas, the Energy
22 Efficiency Community Block Grants ("EECBG") will provide funding for projects resulting in
23 an energy savings for non-profits or municipalities and the Housing Advisory Board ("HAB")
24 funds are non federal dollars which are used to housing related activities; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
27 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the
28 aforementioned funds, in the amount of \$880,323.25;
