A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire one external person into a full-time, non-bargaining unit Computer Systems/Software Analyst 1 position in the Child Support Enforcement Agency of the Prosecutor's Office to fill a vacant position, at a rate of \$19.01 per hour, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit and Ordinance No. 2011-204, which reinstituted the hiring freeze through December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire said employees; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor says it is necessary for the continued and effective operation of her Child Support Enforcement Agency to be permitted to hire and fill one external person into full-time, non-bargaining unit Computer Systems/Software Analyst 1 position; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire one external person into a full-time, non-bargaining unit Computer Systems/Software Analyst 1 position at a rate of \$19.01 per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
