A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement with Oriana House, Inc., for Adult Joint Drug Court programming, for the period of 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, in an amount not to exceed \$588,087.00, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, funded by the Fiscal Year 2012 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration and Fiscal Year 2012 Bureau of Justice Assistance grants, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management — Division of Public Safety and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services has awarded a Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration ("SAMHSA") grant in the amount of \$325,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 9/30/12 through 9/29/13, to the County of Summit, for the operation of a Fiscal Year 2012 Joint Adult Drug Court program; and

WHEREAS, this SAMHSA grant has a project period of 9/30/12 through 9/29/15, for a total award of \$975,000.00, which is subject to performance review; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice has awarded a Bureau of Justice Assistance ("BJA") grant in the amount of \$300,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/15, to the County of Summit, for the operation of a Fiscal Year 2012 Joint Adult Drug Court program; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2013-013, which authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grants and appropriated grant funds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Council to authorize the Executive to execute an agreement with Oriana House, Inc., for Adult Joint Drug Court programming for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, in an amount not to exceed \$588,087.00, funded by the Fiscal Year 2012 SAMHSA and Fiscal Year 2012 BJA grants, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned renewal agreement.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Oriana House, Inc., for Adult Joint Drug Court programming, for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, in an amount not to exceed \$588,087.00, funded by the Fiscal Year 2012 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration ("SAMHSA") and Fiscal Year 2012 Bureau of Justice Assistance ("BJA") grants, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term.
