7 **A Resolution appropriating funds in the amount of \$6,016,375.05 in carryover balances in**
8 **various funds for calendar year 2013, for the Executive's Department of Community and**
9 **Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development has
12 available carryover grant balances within two Community Development Block Grants
13 ("CDBG") of \$453,847.80 for community investment activities, and \$16,454.42 in general
14 administration funding; and

16 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development has
17 an available carryover grant balance within its Home Investment Partnership ("HOME") Grant
18 of \$318,557.00; and

20 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development has
21 carryover grants balances within the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation ("SCLRC")
22 award of \$1,420,569.00 for project investment and in the SCLSC Moving Ohio Forward Grant
23 award of \$3,780,560.00; and

25 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development has
26 a carryover grant balance within the Akron Lead ("Lead") Grant of \$26,386.83; and

28 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover funds from 2012 for 2013
29 operations; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 that the aforementioned appropriations in the amount of \$6,016,375.05 are necessary and in the
33 best interest of the County of Summit;
