An amended Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a sewer services agreement with GOJO Industries, Inc., for its facility at 3783 State Road, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223, in Council District 3, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, GOJO Industries, Inc. ("GOJO"), is the owner and operator of an industrial facility located at 3783 State Road, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223 ("GOJO Facility"), in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, GOJO is an industrial customer of the County Executive's Department of Environmental Services ("DOES") for the sanitary and industrial wastewater discharged from the GOJO Facility; and

WHEREAS, the industrial wastewater discharged from the GOJO Facility is not metered because the high use of water in GOJO's industrial process, among other factors, would make typical metering inaccurate; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 923 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, the Director of DOES has the authority to determine alternate methods to calculate sanitary and industrial wastewater flows that more accurately reflect the volume of discharge by a customer and to establish the terms and conditions of charging said customer for the same; and

WHEREAS, the Director of DOES previously established such an alternative method of calculation for the GOJO Facility, although the same has never been memorialized to a written agreement between the County and GOJO; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and GOJO propose memorializing said alternative method of calculation in a written agreement in order to ensure predictability, stability and certainty in the charges assessed by DOES to GOJO; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute a sewer services agreement, in the form set forth in the attached Exhibit A, with GOJO to establish the aforementioned alternative method of calculation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, that:
