A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan agreement in an amount not to exceed \$4,840,500.00 to finance the design and construction of the Q-949 Springfield Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project, in Council District 8, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, concurrently with this Resolution, the County Executive seeks approval to advertise for bids for the Q-949 Springfield Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project ("Project"), which will provide repair, rehabilitation and replacement of equipment and structures of the County of Summit's Springfield Wastewater Treatment Plant No. 36, in Council District 8, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$4,840,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") loan to finance the design and construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the WPCLF requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

That the County Executive is hereby authorized to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") loan agreement, sign all documents for and enter into a WPCLF loan with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority, in an amount not to exceed \$4,840,500.00, and to finance the design and construction of the Q-949 Springfield Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project ("Project"), located in Council District 8.

SECTION 2

It is estimated that the total cost of Project will not exceed \$4,840,500.00. The interest rate for the 20-year loan shall not exceed 3.4 percent per year. The dedicated source of repayment will be the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow the County to obtain funds for the design and construction of the Project to replace aging equipment and structures at the Springfield Waste Water Treatment Plant.
