A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award of federal funds from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency of a Fiscal Year 2012-2013 hazardous materials emergency preparedness training grant, for the period ending 10/1/13, in the amount of \$12,240.00, with a 20% local cash match requirement of \$3,060.00, and appropriating the total of \$15,300.00 for expenditures made by 10/1/13, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety-Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA") has awarded a Fiscal Year 2012-2013 hazardous materials emergency preparedness grant of federal funds to the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, Division of Public Safety-Emergency Management Agency ("PS-EMA") for the period ending 10/1/13, in the amount of \$12,240.00, with a 20% local cash match requirement of \$3,060.00, to provide for a Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Training program ("HMEP"); and

WHEREAS, the \$15,300.00 will support four radiation specialist training sessions which will provide the training for 68 first responders in the Summit County Plan for incidents involving fixed facility and/or transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Local Emergency Planning Committee ("LEPC") will provide the 20% local cash match requirement of \$3,060.00 from non-federal funds as required by the grantee; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the OEMA and to appropriate these grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of a Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Training program ("HMEP") grant, from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA"), for the period ending 10/1/13, in the amount of \$12,240.00, with a \$3,060.00 local cash match requirement.
