A Resolution declaring the necessity of levying a renewal property tax levy of eight-tenths (0.8) mill for operating and capital expenses for the provision and maintenance of zoological park services and facilities at the Akron Zoological Park, for the Executive and Council, and declaring an emergency

WHEREAS, the Akron Zoological Park has requested this Council to submit the question of an eight-tenths (0.8) mill renewal property tax levy to the voters of Summit County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

### SECTION 1

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Findings and Determinations. This Council makes the following findings and determinations:

- (a) The Akron Zoological Park (the "Akron Zoo"), a nonprofit corporation, operates and maintains a zoological park in the County.
- (b) Section 307.76 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the County to contract with or contribute to a nonprofit corporation to maintain and operate a zoological park in the County and to provide for the acquisition, disposition, and care of the animals to be exhibited at the zoological park, and the County has entered into an agreement with the Akron Zoo dated as of February 22, 2000, as amended as of January 15, 2001, for that purpose.
- (c) Section 5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes Council to submit to the voters the question of levying a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for operating and capital expenses for the provision and maintenance of zoological park services and facilities authorized under Section 307.76 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (d) The voters approved a tax levy (the "Expiring Tax Levy") for that purpose at the November 7, 2006 election in the amount of eight-tenths (0.8) mill. The last collection year of the Expiring Tax Levy is 2014.
- (e) The amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation for the County will be insufficient to provide financial support for the operation and maintenance of the Akron Zoo. It is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation (the "Renewal Tax Levy"), by renewing the Expiring Tax Levy, for operating and capital expenses for the provision and maintenance of zoological park services and facilities at the Akron Zoo.

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## **SECTION 2**

Terms of the Renewal Tax Levy. The Renewal Tax Levy will have the following terms:

- (a) The Renewal Tax Levy will be levied under the authority of Section 5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (b) The Renewal Tax Levy will be in the amount of eight-tenths (0.8) mill for each one dollar of tax value, which amounts to eight cents (\$0.08) for each one hundred dollars of tax value.
- (c) The Renewal Tax Levy will be for a period of seven years, beginning on the tax list and duplicate for the year 2014, the proceeds of which would be first distributed to the County in 2015.

#### **SECTION 3**

Submission of Renewal Tax Levy to Voters. The question of the Renewal Tax Levy will be submitted to the voters of the County at the general election to be held in the County on November 5, 2013. That election will be held at the regular places of voting in the County as established by the Board of Elections of the County, within the times provided by law, and will be conducted, canvassed, and certified in the manner provided by law.

### **SECTION 4**

Request of County Fiscal Officer. In accordance with Section 5705.03, Revised Code, this Council requests the County Fiscal Officer to certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the Renewal Tax Levy in the amount of eight-tenths (0.8) mill.

## **SECTION 5**

Ballot Form. The form of the ballot will be substantially as follows:

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Summit County

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the County of Summit, Ohio for the purpose of operating and capital expenses for the provision and maintenance of zoological park services and facilities at the Akron Zoo at a rate not exceeding eight-tenths (0.8) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to eight cents (\$0.08) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of seven years.

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#### SECTION 6

Statement of Emergency. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the County, and for the further reason that this resolution is required to be immediately effective to enable the County Fiscal Officer to calculate the amounts requested in Section 4 and to certify the question to the Board of Elections in time for the November 5, 2013 election.

# **SECTION 7**

Effective Date. Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it will take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it will take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

### **SECTION 8**

Open Meetings. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
