SECTION 1

This Council hereby authorizes the Executive to execute the Tax Lien Sale Agreement, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, with such revisions and modifications as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of the Tax Lien Sale Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by execution thereof by the County Executive.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to timely assist the City and the Authority with securing the payment of debt service on the Bonds.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
