NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, that:

SECTION 1

B

This Council hereby expresses its support for, and urges the Ohio General Assembly to enact, S.B. 134 to ensure that Ohio port authorities are able to effectively compete for, and continue their participation in, economic development, job creation and infrastructure projects in the State of Ohio.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately expressing support for S.B. 134 during the time it is being considered by the Ohio General Assembly.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
