A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with REXEL to provide replacement parts for pump station operations, as Best Practical Source, in an amount not to exceed \$26,480.82, for an aggregate total of \$39,896.01 in calendar year 2013, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit requires that purchases by an officeholder exceeding \$25,000.00 in aggregate in any calendar year, where no additional competitive quotes or bids have been taken for the project, shall be made only upon authorization of County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control has previously approved purchases in aggregate totaling \$13,415.19 for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services with REXEL, as Best Practical Source, for pump station operations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 22, 2013, awarded a purchase contract with REXEL to provide additional replacement parts, in the amount of \$14,641.58, which will exceed the aggregate total of \$25,000.00 in the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the approval of aforementioned purchase contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-289

The award of a purchase contract with REXEL to provide replacement parts for pump station operations, as Best Practical Source, in an amount not to exceed \$26,480.82, for an aggregate total of \$39,896.01 in calendar year 2013, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide the necessary replacement parts for pump station operations for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services.
