WHEREAS, the County Executive and Sheriff wish for this Council to authorize the County Executive to execute a professional service contract, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, with Chima Travel Bureau, Inc. for a total amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, for a term from 7/1/13 through 6/30/14, with four options to renew for additional one-year terms; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional contract with Chima Travel Bureau, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County and that the Executive should be authorized to execute the same, subject to the approval of the Board of Control;

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned professional service contract with Chima Travel Bureau, Inc. because the Sheriff's Office needs to continue to perform prisoner extraditions via air travel.
