SECTION 1

 Chapter 943 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, Comprehensive Storm Water Management," is hereby adopted in the version set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for further purpose of immediately addressing water quality and flooding issues within the County.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4
