7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute amendments to the Moving Ohio**
8 **Forward Demolition Program Subrecipient Agreements with the City of Barberton and**
9 **Coventry Township to increase the County's grants under said Agreements, for the**
10 **Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County and City of Barberton ("City") entered into a Moving Ohio
14 Forward Demolition Program Agreement ("City Agreement") on September 19, 2012, as
15 authorized by Resolution No. 2012-310; and

16
17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section IV of the City Agreement, the County is providing the
18 City total funding of \$870,097.30 for demolition activities, which have been granted to the
19 County by the Summit County Land Revitalization Corporation, and the City is contributing an
20 additional \$482,552.00 in local funds; and

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22 WHEREAS, the County desires to increase the amount granted to the City under the City
23 Agreement by \$34,500.00, in order to provide for additional demolitions in the City and to
24 reallocate unused funds from other communities; and

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26 WHEREAS, the County and City desire to amend the City Agreement to provide the
27 aforementioned additional funds; and

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29 WHEREAS, the County and Coventry Township ("Township") entered into a Moving
30 Ohio Forward Demolition Program Agreement ("Township Agreement") on September 27,
31 2012, as authorized by Resolution No. 2012-310; and

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33 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section IV of the Township Agreement, the County is providing
34 the Township total funding of \$57,518.53 for demolition activities, which have been granted to
35 the County by the Summit County Land Revitalization Corporation, and the Township is
36 contributing an additional \$15,000.00 in local funds; and

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38 WHEREAS, the County desires to increase the amount granted to the Township under
39 the Township Agreement by \$25,000.00, in order to provide for additional demolitions in the
40 Township and to reallocate unused funds from other communities; and

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42 WHEREAS, the County and Township desire to amend the Township Agreement to
43 provide the aforementioned additional funds; and

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45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
46 that it is necessary and is the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the
47 aforementioned amendments to the City Agreement and Township Agreement.

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49 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the Moving Ohio
7 Forward Demolition Program Subrecipient Agreement with the City of Barberton to increase the
8 County's grant under said City Agreement by \$34,500.00 to a total amount of \$904,597.30. The
9 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the Moving Ohio
10 Forward Demolition Program Subrecipient Agreement with Coventry Township to increase the
11 County's grant under said Township Agreement by \$25,000.00 to a total amount of \$82,518.53.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
16 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately
17 authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendments so that Moving Ohio Forward
18 Demolition Program Funds can be timely expended.

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20 SECTION 3

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22 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
23 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
24 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

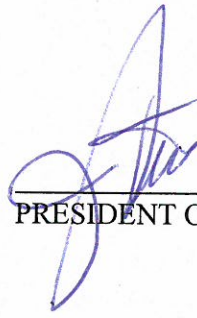
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26 SECTION 4
