7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a**
8 **2013-2014 Victims of Crime Act grant award, in the amount of \$31,434.00 with a local cash**
9 **match requirement of \$10,478.00, along with an additional supplement of \$18,088.00 in**
10 **Title IV-E funds, for a total of \$60,000.00, and a 2013-2014 State Victims Assistance Act**
11 **grant award, in the amount of \$3,286.00, with no local cash match requirement, both from**
12 **the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14 and**
13 **appropriating funds in the amount of \$63,286.00 through 12/31/13 for the Court of**
14 **Common Pleas –Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**
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16 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a 2013-2014
17 Victims of Crime Act (“VOCA”) grant, to help support a volunteer coordinator staff position, in
18 the amount of \$31,434.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$10,478.00 which has been
19 provided for in an appropriation within the Juvenile Court’s annual budget legislation in
20 Resolution No. 12-475; and
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22 WHEREAS, an additional supplement from Title IV-E funds in the amount of
23 \$18,088.00 is required in order to fully cover salary and benefits for this volunteer coordinator
24 position which will coordinate the services that are provided to child abuse victims by the Court
25 Appointed Special Advocate (“CASA”) child volunteer advocates and the Court child advocates;

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28 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a 2013-2014 State
29 Victims Assistance Act (“SVAA”) grant award in the amount of \$3,286.00 with no local cash
30 match requirement, for various expenses in program supplies and contract services; and
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32 WHEREAS, both the VOCA and the SVAA grants have been ongoing annual federal-
33 pass-through funding awards from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, and operate on the
34 Federal Fiscal Year with this current award being for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14; and
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36 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
37 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
38 any document necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio Office of
39 the Attorney General and to appropriate these grant funds;
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41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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46 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
47 the VOCA award in the amount of \$31,434.00 with a cash match of \$10,478.00, and an
48 additional supplement of \$18,088.00 in Title IV-E funds, and SVAA award in the amount of
49 \$3,286.00 from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14.

32 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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
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4 SECTION 6


