7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept**
8 **an award of a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety - Office of Criminal Justice**
9 **Services, for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated Task Force Program,**
10 **in the amount of \$217,881.72 in federal funds, with no local cash match requirement, for the**
11 **period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14, and appropriating grant funds totaling \$217,881.72, for the**
12 **period 10/1/13 through 12/31/13, and confirming an award by the Board of Control of a**
13 **blanket purchase order to various county law enforcement agencies, in an aggregate not to**
14 **exceed \$80,295.54, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, through the Office of Criminal Justice
17 Services ("OCJS"), has awarded the County Sheriff a grant in the amount of \$217,881.72 in federal
18 funds, for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force Program
19 in order to conduct high visibility enforcement, public awareness, and education for alcohol-related
20 crashes and traffic-related fatalities in the County of Summit, for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14;
21 and

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23 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate all grant funds for the period 10/1/13 through
24 12/31/13; and

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26 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 9, 2013, awarded a blanket
27 purchase order for payment to the police departments of Akron, Barberton, Boston Heights, New
28 Franklin, Peninsula, Richfield, Silver Lake, Stow, Medina and Springfield, in an amount not to
29 exceed \$80,295.54; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that
32 it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to
33 execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned OCJS grant, to approve the award by
34 the Board of Control of the purchase order for payments to law enforcement agencies OVI Task
35 Force services to appropriate grant funds, and to confirm the aforementioned blanket purchase order,
36 in an amount not to exceed \$80,295.54; and

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of
39 Ohio, that:

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41 SECTION 1

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43 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept a
44 grant award in the amount of \$217,881.72, in federal funds, with no local cash match requirement,
45 from the Ohio Department of Public Safety - Office of Criminal Justice Services, for a countywide
46 Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force Program, for the period 10/1/13
47 through 9/30/14.

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27 The award by the Board of Control of a blanket purchase order to the police departments of
28 Akron, Barberton, Boston Heights, New Franklin, Peninsula, Richfield, Silver Lake, Stow, Medina
29 and Springfield, in an amount not to exceed \$80,295.54, is hereby confirmed and the County
30 Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase order.

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32 SECTION 5

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize
36 the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the grant from the Office of Criminal
37 Justice Services for the OVI Task Force Program, confirm the award of the purchase order for
38 payment to various law enforcement agencies for OVI Task Force services and appropriate grant
39 funds for the period 10/1/13 through 12/31/13.

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41 SECTION 6

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
44 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be
45 in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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4 SECTION 7

7 the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in
