A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award of a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety - Office of Criminal Justice Services, for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated Task Force Program, in the amount of \$217,881.72 in federal funds, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14, and appropriating grant funds totaling \$217,881.72, for the period 10/1/13 through 12/31/13, and confirming an award by the Board of Control of a blanket purchase order to various county law enforcement agencies, in an aggregate not to exceed \$80,295.54, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, through the Office of Criminal Justice Services ("OCJS"), has awarded the County Sheriff a grant in the amount of \$217,881.72 in federal funds, for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force Program in order to conduct high visibility enforcement, public awareness, and education for alcohol-related crashes and traffic-related fatalities in the County of Summit, for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate all grant funds for the period 10/1/13 through 12/31/13; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 9, 2013, awarded a blanket purchase order for payment to the police departments of Akron, Barberton, Boston Heights, New Franklin, Peninsula, Richfield, Silver Lake, Stow, Medina and Springfield, in an amount not to exceed \$80,295.54; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned OCJS grant, to approve the award by the Board of Control of the purchase order for payments to law enforcement agencies OVI Task Force services to appropriate grant funds, and to confirm the aforementioned blanket purchase order, in an amount not to exceed \$80,295.54; and
