A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to award a grant to the City of Hudson, in the amount of \$60,000.00, from the Fiscal Year 2011 Metropolitan Medical Response System grant program funds, in Council District 3, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management - Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Emergency Management Agency ("EMA") receives Metropolitan Medical Response System ("MMRS") funds on an annual basis to provide capabilities to better mitigate, prepare, respond and recover from an act of terrorism and other disasters within the medical and first responder communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson requested Fiscal Year 2011 MMRS funding, in the amount of \$60,000.00, to assist with the purchase of radios in order to join the Summit County/Akron 800 MHz Regional Radio System; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Domestic Preparedness Steering Committee, the grant's oversight committee, has previously recommended approval of this award; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to award the aforementioned grant to the City of Hudson;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
