7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute the renewal (first of two) of an**
8 **agreement with Oriana House, Inc., for Adult Joint Drug Court programming, for the**
9 **period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, in an amount not to exceed \$293,687.00, funded by the**
10 **Fiscal Year 2012 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration grant, for the**
11 **Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public**
12 **Safety and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services has awarded a
15 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration (“SAMHSA”) grant, in an amount not to
16 exceed \$975,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the project period 9/30/12
17 through 9/29/15, to the County of Summit, for the operation of a Fiscal Year 2012 Joint Adult
18 Drug Court program; and

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20 WHEREAS, these grants are provided in annual installments of \$325,000.00 and subject
21 to performance reviews; and

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23 WHEREAS, SAMHSA has awarded the second installment of the grant, in an amount
24 not to exceed \$325,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 9/30/13 through
25 9/29/14, to the County of Summit, for the operation of a Fiscal Year 2012 Joint Adult Drug
26 Court program; and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-018, which authorized
29 the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grants
30 and appropriated grant funds; and

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32 WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Council to authorize the Executive to execute a
33 renewal to the agreement with Oriana House, Inc., for Adult Joint Drug Court programming, for
34 the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, in an amount not to exceed \$293,687.00, funded by the
35 Fiscal Year 2012 SAMHSA grant; and

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37 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
38 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
39 execute the aforementioned renewal.;
