A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with GE Intelligent Platforms to upgrade existing iFix SCADA to virtual hardware and upgrade of plant/pump station control software to current standard, as Sole Source, approved by the IT Board 2/25/14, in an amount not to exceed \$33,994.87, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 26, 2014, awarded a professional service contract with GE Intelligent Platforms to upgrade existing iFix SCADA to virtual hardware and upgrade of plant/pump station control software to current standard, as Sole Source, approved by the IT Board 2/25/14, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with GE Intelligent Platforms to upgrade existing iFix SCADA to virtual hardware and upgrade of plant/pump station control software to current standard, as Sole Source, approved by the IT Board 2/25/14, in an amount not to exceed \$33,994.87, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide the upgrades in 2014.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4
