AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PRIVATELY FINANCED PUMP STATION AND SANITARY SEWER LINES between CAM INC., CAM GREEN, LLC and COUNTY OF SUMMIT

This Amendment to the Agreements for Construction of Privately Financed Sanitary Sewer Lines and Pump Station is entered into between the County of Summit, Ohio, an Ohio political subdivision ("County"), CAM Inc. and CAM Green, LLC (collectively, the "Developer").

Whereas, on or about July 25, 2011, County and Developer entered into the Agreement for Construction of Privately Financed Sanitary Sewer Lines ("Sewer Lines Agreement") for the construction of a sanitary sewer extension located in the City of Green; known as Heritage Crossings of Green Pump Station, Sanitary Improvement #9521-1; and

Whereas, on or about August 11, 2011, County and Developer entered into the Agreement for Construction of Privately Financed Pump Station ("Pump Station Agreement") for the construction of a sanitary sewer pump station and appurtenances located in the City of Green; known as Heritage Crossings of Green Pump Station, Sanitary Improvement #9521-P; and

Whereas, the County, for operational reasons and future planning, requested that Developer oversize 950 linear feet of the sanitary sewer extension from 18" to 24" diameter pipe; and

Whereas, for operational reasons, the County requested the Developer to perform further work and tests on certain equipment in the relocation and construction of the new pump station pursuant to the Pump Station Agreement;

Whereas, it is proper to reimburse Developer for the above oversizing and additional work performed;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Developer shall be entitled to compensation under the Sewer Line Agreement and Pump Station Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$17,804.64 for pipe oversizing and additional allowed expenses as detailed in Exhibit "A", attached to and incorporated with this Amendment.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Sewer Line Agreement and Pump Station Agreement not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

Intending to be legally bound, the parties have executed this Amendment as of the date signed by the Executive for the County of Summit.
