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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Montrose Ford, Inc. for four new unmarked vehicles, under CUE Pricing, in a total**
9 **amount not to exceed \$104,120.79, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 17, 2017, awarded a
12 purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc. for one 2017 Ford 4WD unmarked Explorer, one
13 2017 Chevrolet unmarked Impala, one 2017 Chevrolet AWD unmarked Equinox, one 2017
14 Chevrolet AWD unmarked Traverse, under CUE pricing, in a total amount not to exceed
15 \$104,120.79, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
18 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc., is necessary and in the best
19 interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc. for
27 one 2017 Ford 4WD unmarked Explorer, one 2017 Chevrolet unmarked Impala, one 2017
28 Chevrolet AWD unmarked Equinox, one 2017 Chevrolet AWD unmarked Traverse, under CUE
29 pricing, in a total amount not to exceed \$104,120. is hereby confirmed and the County Executive
30 is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
36 replace unreliable vehicles for the Sheriff's Drug Unit Task Force in 2016.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
