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7 **A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations, in the amount of \$32,892.17, within the**
8 **Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division's budget for the Family Drug Court**
9 **Implementation Project, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring**
10 **an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2013-438, which
13 authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from
14 the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention of a
15 Family Drug Court Implementation Project grant, for the Fiscal Years 2014 through 2016, in the
16 amount of \$538,363.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating these grant
17 funds for the period of 10/1/13 through 9/30/16; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Family Drug Court Implementation Project is a collaboration with
20 Summit County Children Services and a myriad of local service providers; and

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22 WHEREAS, the goal of this funding is to partner with families to address substance
23 abuse and other family challenges to create a healthy, stable home environment and permanently
24 reunify the family; and

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26 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice has approved a one-year extension of the
27 Family Drug Court Implementation Project, for the period 10/1/16 through 9/30/17; and

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29 WHEREAS, the extension allows the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division to
30 continue paying salaries to the Drug Court Coordinator and Summit County Children Services
31 Social Worker Assistant; and

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33 WHEREAS, the extension allows the Juvenile Division to continue paying for data
34 support and evaluation by the Human Services Research Institute as required by the U.S.
35 Department of Justice; and

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37 WHEREAS, because of the one-year extension, it is necessary to adjust appropriations
38 within the Juvenile Division's budget for the Family Drug Court Implementation Project, in the
39 amount of \$32,892.17; and

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41 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
42 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to adjust appropriations
43 within the Juvenile Division's budget for the Family Drug Court Implementation Project, in the
44 amount of \$32,892.17;
