7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award from the County Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services of a**
9 **Federal Fiscal Year 2017 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families grant to the Court of**
10 **Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for its Family Resource Center, for the period 10/1/16**
11 **through 9/30/17, in the amount of \$419,799.00, with no local cash match requirement, and**
12 **appropriating said grant funds, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and**
13 **declaring an emergency.**

15 WHEREAS, the County Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services has
16 awarded a Federal Fiscal Year 2017 (“FFY 2017”) Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
17 (“TANF”) grant to the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for its Family Resource
18 Center, for the period 10/1/16 through 9/30/17, in the amount of \$419,799.00, with no local cash
19 match requirement; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Family Resource Center, which was established in 2006 through a grant
22 from DJFS, provides case management to at risk youth and their families who are involved in
23 domestic violence disputes, are pregnant or parenting teens, are teens at risk of dropping out of
24 school or are returning from long term stays at the Ohio Department of Youth Services, detention
25 or other placements; and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-306, which confirmed
28 an award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental agreement with the Juvenile Division
29 to provide a youth and family strengthening program, for a one-year term, for the period 10/1/16
30 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$419,799.00; and

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32 WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY 2017 TANF
33 grant from DJFS and to appropriate said grant funds; and

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35 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
36 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
37 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY 2017 TANF
38 grant from DJFS and to appropriate said grant funds;

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40 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
41 of Ohio, that:

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45 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
46 the award from the County Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services of a Federal
47 Fiscal Year 2017 (“FFY 2017”) Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) grant to the
48 Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for its Family Resource Center, for the period 10/1/16
49 through 9/30/17, in the amount of \$419,799.00, with no local cash match requirement.

21 authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the FFY
22 2017 TANF grant effective 10/1/16 and appropriate said grant funds.

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26 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
27 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
28 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
