Limbert in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio, alleging violation of federal and state disability and gender discrimination statutes (the "Lawsuit"); and |
| | WHEREAS, on June 29, 2016, Magistrate Judge Limbert issued a memorandum and opinion granting the County's motion for summary judgment; and |
| | WHEREAS, Ms. Watters subsequently filed an appeal to the United States Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals (the "Appeal"); and |
