WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore has requested that the County grant it an easement, in exchange for payment of \$1.00, across County owned real property in the Village at the location of the former Edwin Shaw Hospital for Rehabilitation, Parcel No. 5401964, in County District 8, for the purpose of installing water lines; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to execute said easement to the Village of Lakemore for the aforementioned purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

DECOLUTION NO

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an easement to the Village of Lakemore, in exchange for payment by the Village of \$1.00, for the purpose of installing waterlines. The Executive is hereby authorized to execute said easement in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it will immediately authorize the Executive to execute a necessary easement to the Village of Lakemore for the purpose of installing waterlines.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
